ABOUT THE PROGRAM

What is LeadWell Advanced?

LeadWell Advanced: Trauma-Informed Leadership & Management Certificate IV (BSB40520) is a nationally recognised, accredited program designed for team leaders, room leaders and directors working in early childhood and community services. The program integrates core leadership and management skills with trauma-informed practice so leaders can guide teams with compassion, resilience and practical capability.

Family & Child Consultants delivers LeadWell Advanced as a leadership and educator upskilling program for ECEC and preschool services. It is suited to services wanting to strengthen reflective supervision, staff wellbeing, inclusive leadership, communication, team culture and whole-service quality improvement.

Use action planning and workplace-based projects to translate learning into service improvement.

Build leadership confidence

Develop practical management capability while working toward a nationally recognised qualification.

DELIVERY MODEL

How the program is delivered

Total duration	Approximately 13 hours of structured learning and mentoring, plus workplace-based project work.
Session structure	4 x 2-hour sector-specific interactive workshops plus 5 x 1-hour individual mentoring sessions per participant.
Scheduling	Usually delivered over 4-6 months, with workshops fortnightly or monthly to support workplace application.
Delivery modes	Live online, in-person or blended delivery.
Group size	Standard package includes up to 5 participants; additional participants quoted separately.
Facilitation	Delivered by experienced Family & Child Consultants facilitators and mentors specialising in trauma-informed leadership.
Accreditation	Nationally recognised Certificate IV in Leadership and Management (BSB40520), delivered in partnership with KnowledgeAccess RTO 40961.
